
Hingham Centre Play Area

The Hingham Centre Playground, previously part of the former Centre Elementary School, sits on a parcel of land wedged between School Street and the Hingham Centre Cemetery, and has served the community for nearly a **century**.

But it was closed indefinitely in 2017

With no available budget to replace the deteriorated equipment, the Town of Hingham closed the playground in the spring of 2017 **indefinitely** due to safety and accessibility concerns.



That's when the community stepped in

- In June 2018, the Town of Hingham approved the construction of a new playground designed with input from the community, town and state officials, playground manufacturers and installers, and local landscape architect Sean Papich
- On December 12, 2019, the Town issued a letter of affirmation stating that they will build the new play area this spring provided that they are able to secure all of the necessary funding


Play Area Design



A new play area for future generations


- The <u>new play area</u>*, like the old one, will feature three pieces of play equipment: a swingset, see-saw, and climber
- The play surface will comprise engineered wood mulch and a discrete rubber pathway for safety and accessibility
- Although for younger kids, the design is dynamic for older kids too
- Equipment will be painted dark green to blend the surroundings
